



EZ-LDAP – Catalogue service

With the plug-in EZ-LDAP the administration and user handling in EZbooking can be simplified. Thanks to EZ-LDAP a user environment with a so called "single-sign-on" can be created in the booking system. This means the login to Artologik can be integrated with the login to Windows, hence making the entire login procedure automated.

A connection to a catalogue service (Active Directory) makes it possible to eliminate double administration since user information is collected and updated automatically. It does not matter if information is changed or added to EZbooking or another program using the same directory. Information is collected and updated everywhere!

This is how it works

The same procedure for login is used in the Artologik programs as in the other systems used within your organisation. For example the users have the same user name and password as to the ordinary network.

Other user information, such as name, email address and telephone number, is imported directly from the LDAP catalogue and are kept updated. An update occurs each time the user logs in to the Artologik programs, or when the administrator chooses to import user information. The update can also be made automatically, for example each night.

Configuration

The configuration is made via an interface which only one user in the system has access to. In the interface search paths and login details to the data source is set. The import catalogues from where the users are imported are then defined. You can collect users from several different catalogues.

The advantages with LDAP

There are many advantages with using EZ-LDAP, primarily for the network administrator. One of the major advantages is that the administrator only have to type the information about a user in one place; authorizations in the network, which applications the user has access to and so on. When the information needs to be changed you only have to do it centrally. Something which makes the work less heavy for the administrator.

With a purchase licence of the program a so called "single-sign-on" environment can be created. For the individual user this means that once you have logged in to the network, no further login credentials are required in order to get access to EZbooking.
