Registration

A new possibility to add registrations just for the sake of comments

Normally a validation is made every time a user makes a registration of time, to guarantee that the project, activity, time code and time is entered. After an adjustment among the settings under *Administration > Organisation settings > Registration*, the system allows registrations without time. Such a registration could be used to leave information to a project, for example if a user would want to report him-/herself sick.

Individual limits for the minimum and maximum of registrations

The administrators of the system define a general minimum and maximum concerning a separate time registration, as well as the total of time registrations for a user during a day. If the administrators want to make an exception for a particular user, they can define the user's individual limits in the user information, in the directory. These limits cannot be adjusted by the user himself.

Plan time in a Gantt chart without Java Applets

In order to evaluate the projects and to analyse the financial result in the business, you have a great use of the comparison between the concepts *Planned time* and *Registered time*. From the page *Project < Plan time* you get the graphical overview of the project in a Gantt chart. You can make adjustments of start and end date for every member, in every activity, as well as allot time for the members. The utility graph in the bottom of the page, helps you to keep an eye on the utility of the entire staff, a certain group, or a specific user during time period in mind, while you are adjusting the planning.

The page *Plan time* does not contain Java applets anymore. We have improved the display, but the general appearance and functions of the page are the same.
